

Sammilani Mahavidyalaya, established in 1996 and offering undergraduate courses and programmes to the students hailing from southern part of Kolkata and South 24 Parganas and to the affiliated to the University of Calcutta, and Government of West Bengal aided college, represented by its Principal, Dr. Chandan Kumar Jana hereinafter referred to as the SECOND PARTY (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to mean and include its successor in office, representatives, administrators, and assigns). Both these organizations will be hereinafter referred to as Parties.

### II. PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

Both the Parties are pleased to enter upon an agreement to establish ties of academic cooperation in order to contribute to the achievement of their overall goals as institutions of higher education through following but not limited to:

1. Joint teaching-learning and internship
2. Collaboration in the area of research, publications, project work, etc.

**VI. NON-EXCLUSIVITY:**



2. 2.) The college will publicise and promote the TMYS projects to its students so that whoever wants to make a submission can do so. All the submission terms of TMYS will apply as is. Submission does not necessarily translate into publication.

2. 3.) The college will recommend Project Assistants for the year. TMYS will select 1 (ONE) student per project under *TMYS Review*. The Project Assistants will receive certificates for their work.

2. 4.) The college will bring 3 speakers per project from their network. No repetition of speakers in a year.

2. 5.) The college shall bring 2 (TWO) paid submissions from the students/faculty per project.
