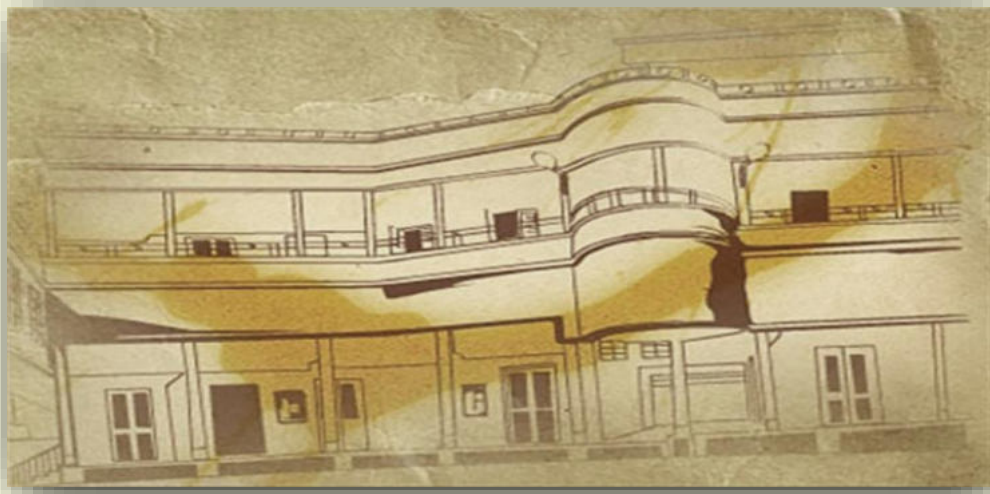



Global Navigation satellite system (GNSS) is a general term describing any satellite constellation that provides positioning, navigation and timing services on a global or regional basis.



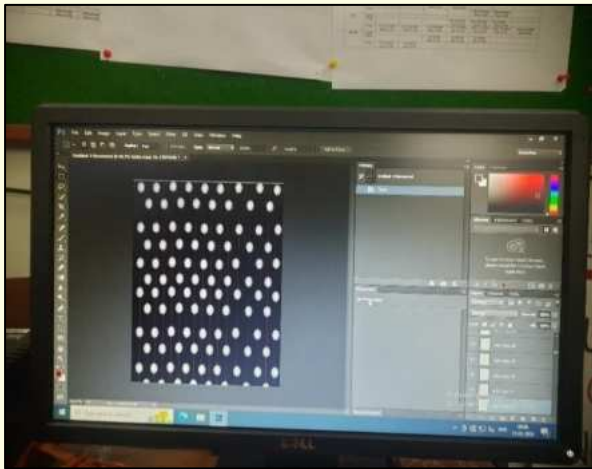

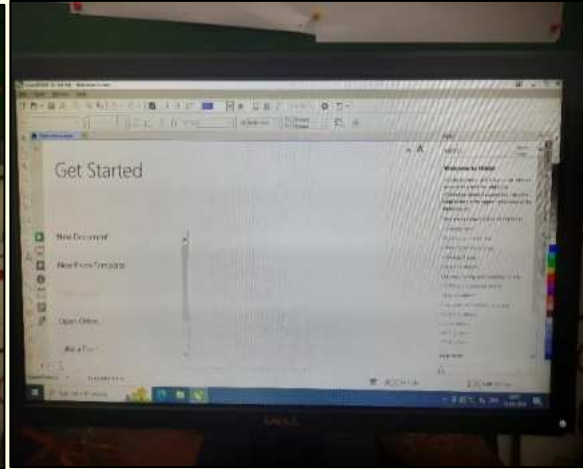

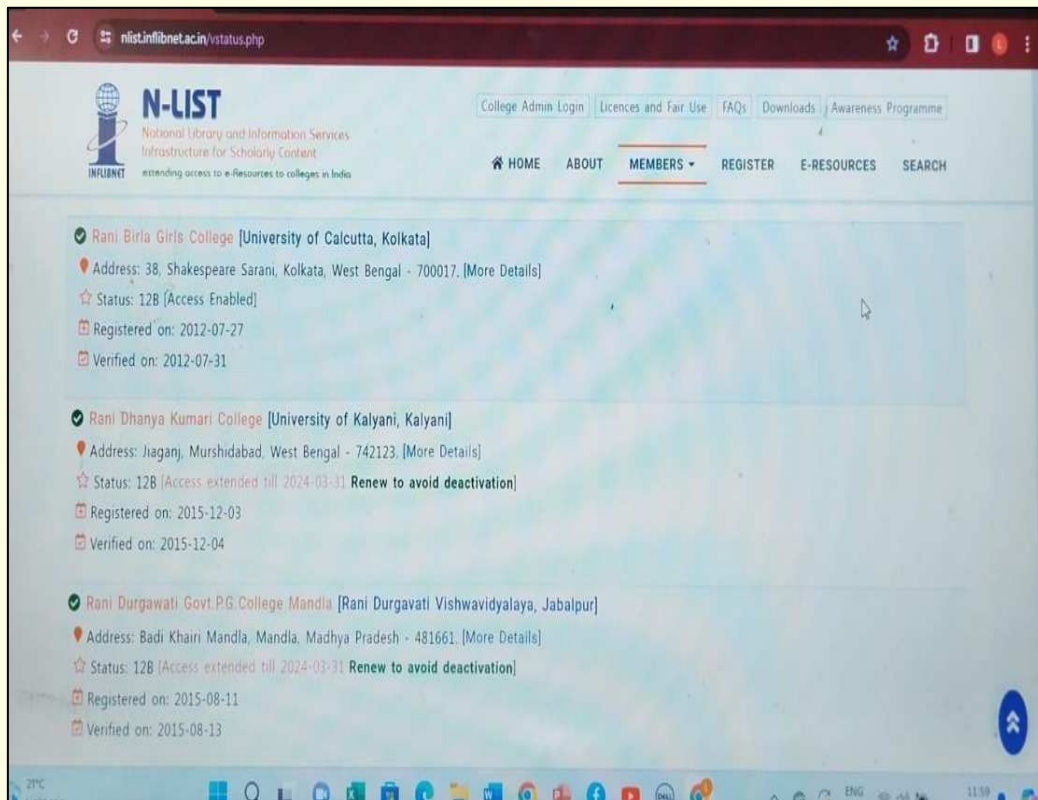

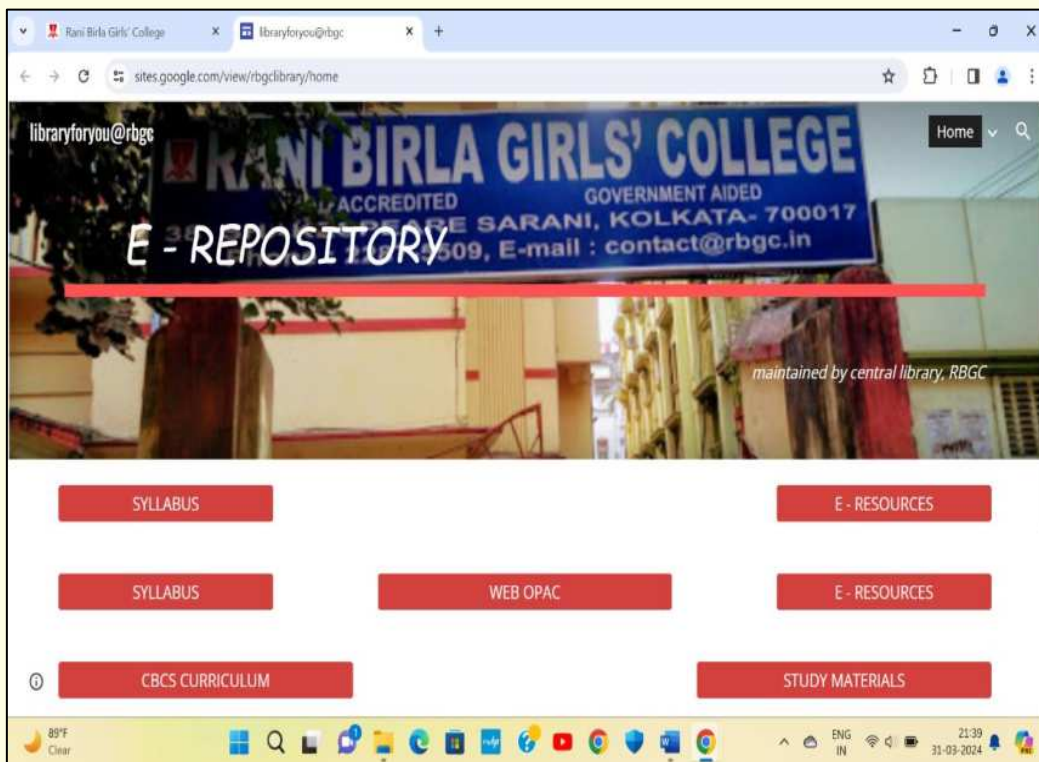


Image 2: Home Screen of the E Repository of College Library

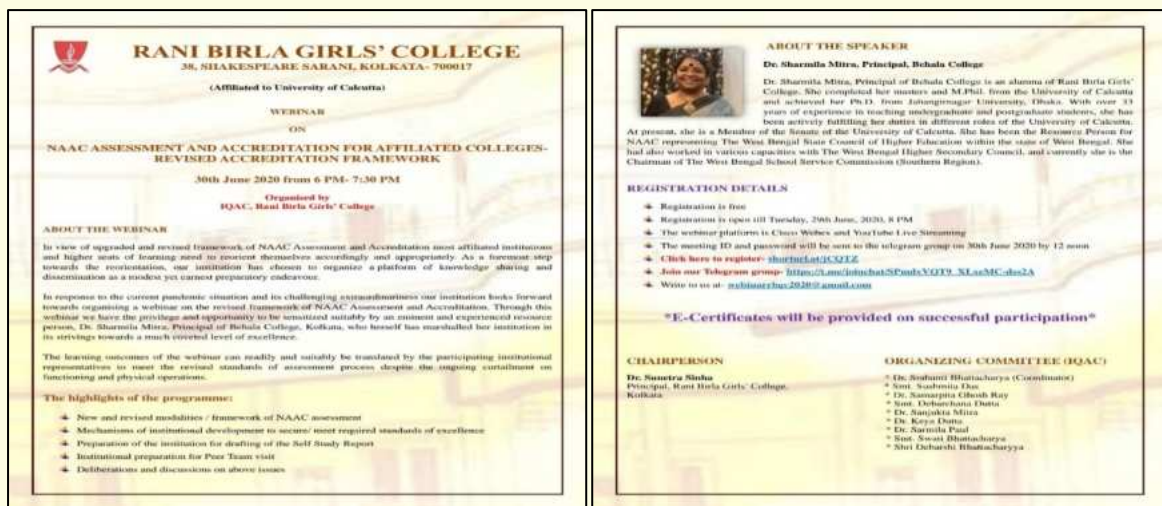

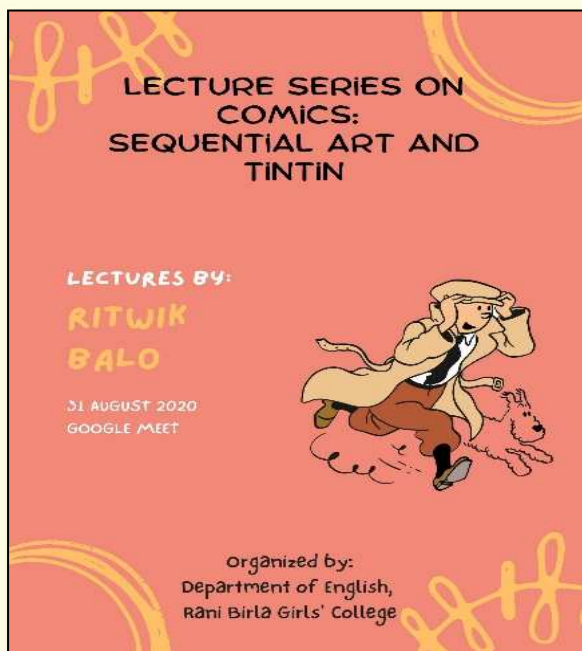

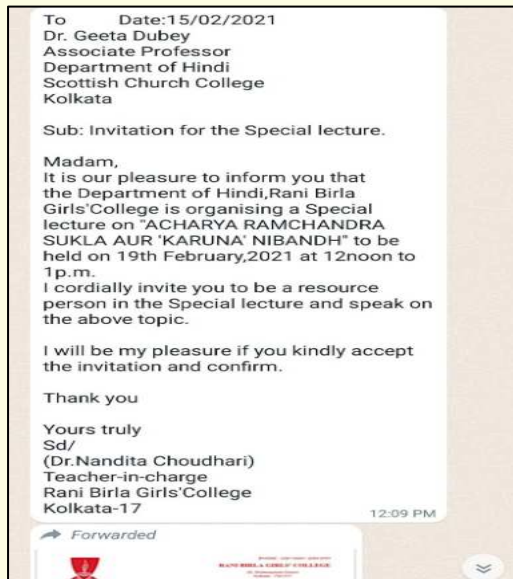


Image 2. Screenshot of the Lecture cum Attendance Record

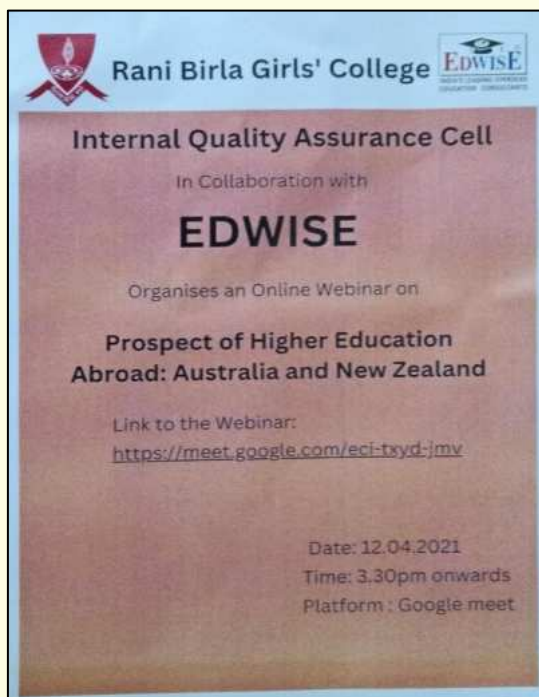

Beckett's plays, characterized by minimalistic settings and fragmented dialogues, serve as a critical lens through which the lecture interrogates the very nature of modernity in theatrical expression.

9th September: Suffragette by Sarah Gavron

Even through the architects of the Indian Constitution ensured voting rights to women from the moment of Independence, it is fact that until only around 100 years ago, women did not have the right to vote in most countries (including countries like the USA, UK and most other European Countries). In the absence of the right to vote, the lives of women were entirely dictated by the will of men. Suffragette documents the struggles of women to win their right to vote – the right to have a say in their own lives, to be treated as equals.

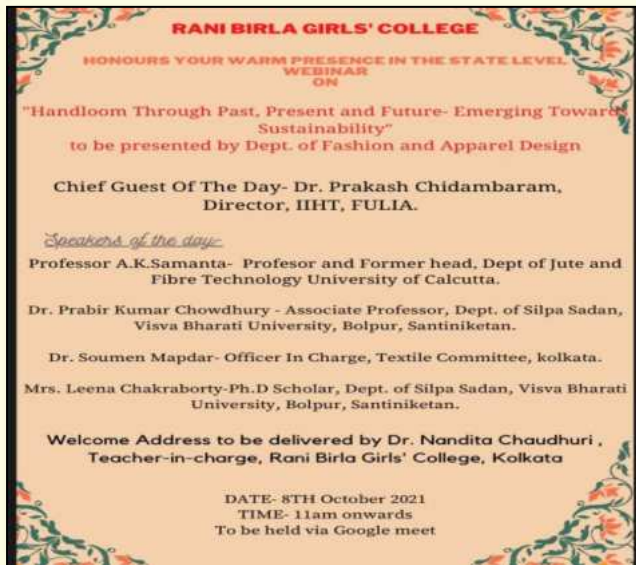

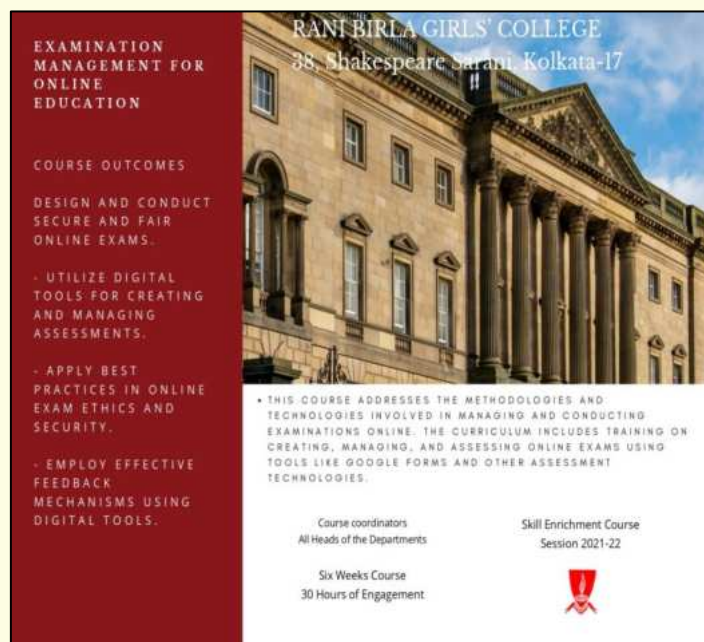

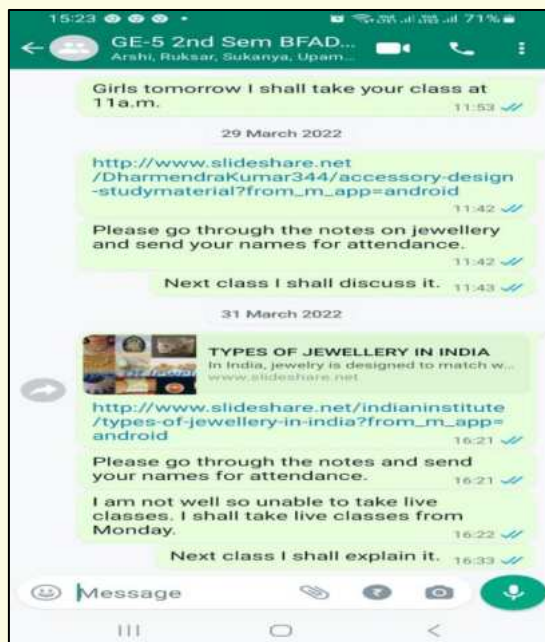


Image 1. Fashion and Apparel Design Department

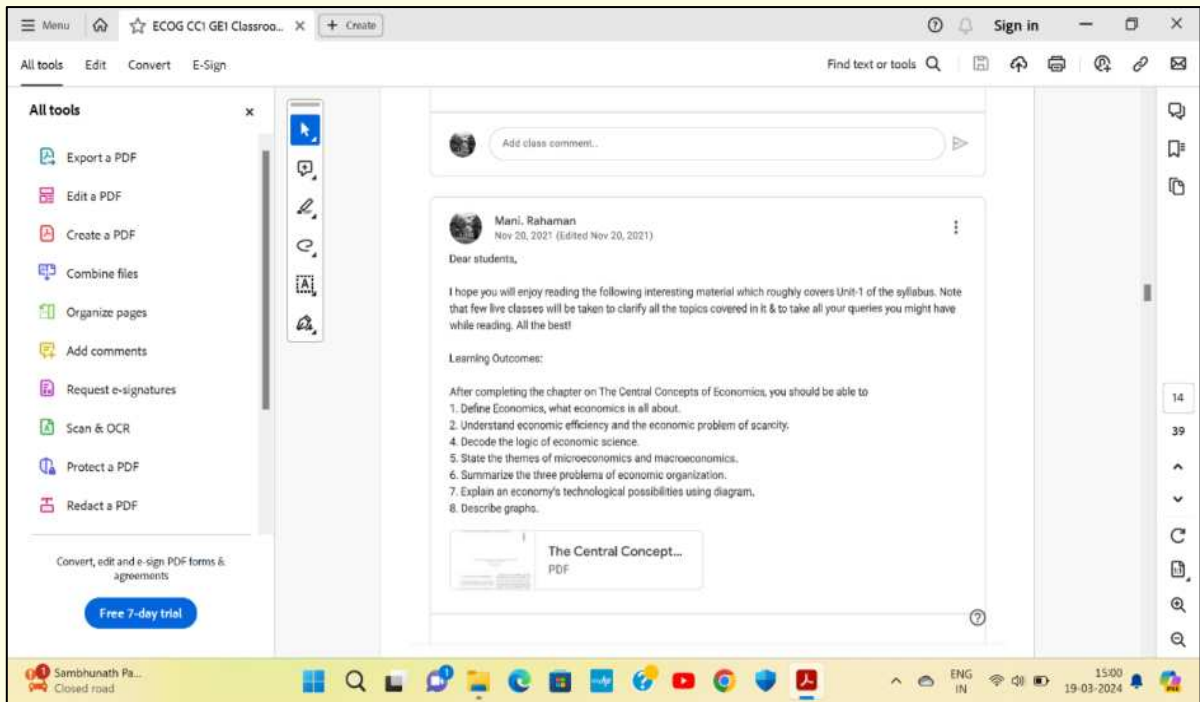


Image 2. Economics Department

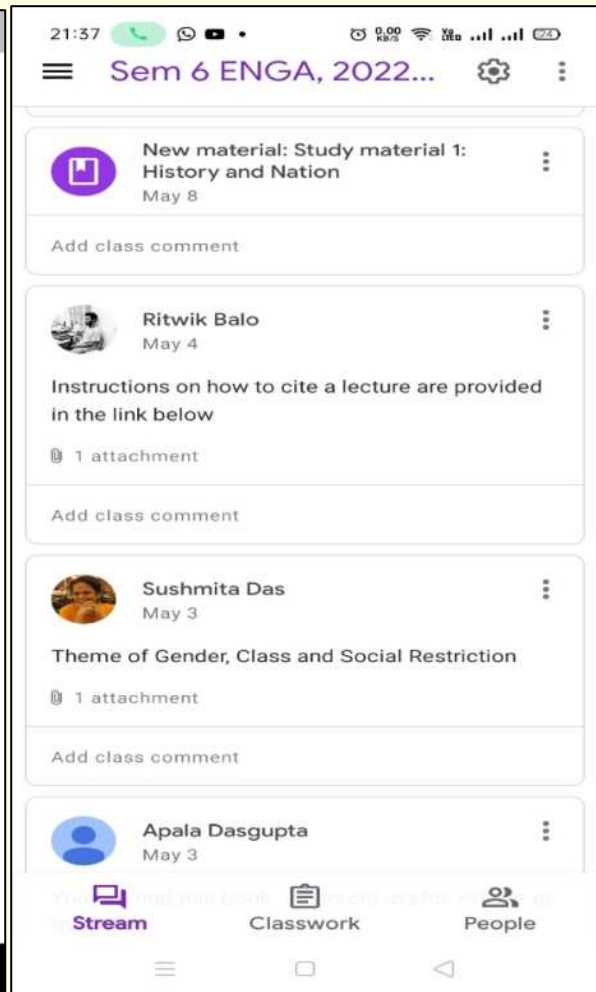

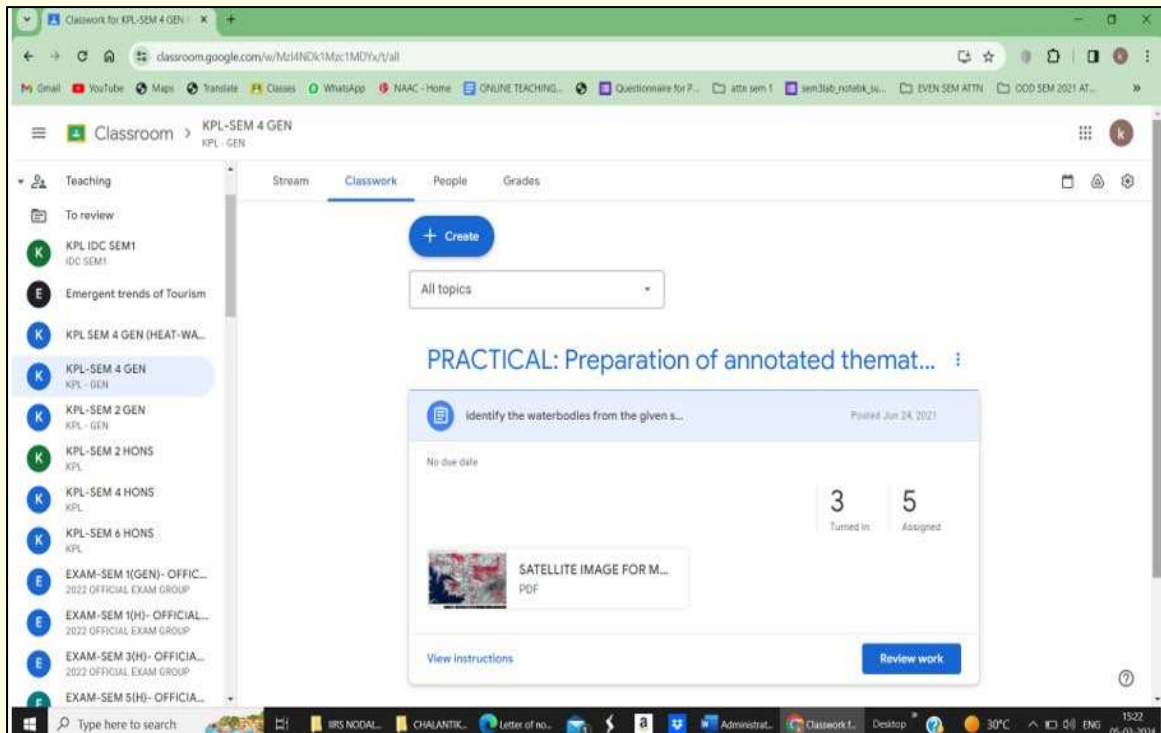

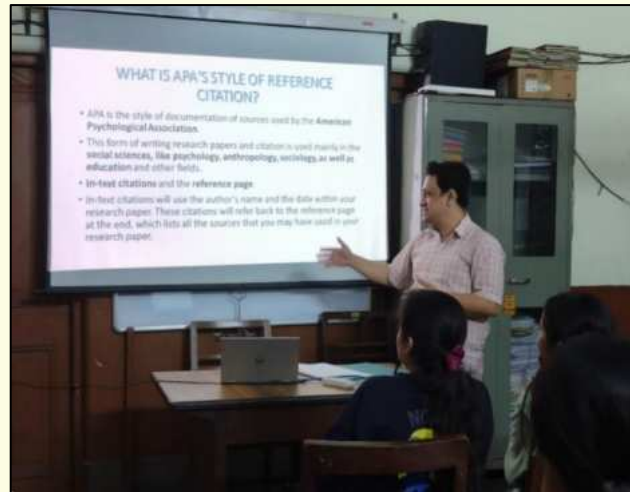
